Minutes of a meeting held at 7.45 p.m. at the Memorial Hall 30th September 1999

- (377) No apologies received.
- (378) Minutes of the meeting held 29/7/99 were agreed to be a true record and signed as such by the chairman.
- (379) Matters arising: The details concerning the siting and costs for speed restriction signs in the village have been presented in the Wensum Diary. The Council awaits comment from the parishioners.
Mick Battams from Lenwade News has been co-opted as a Council member by unanimous decision to replace Steve Norris.
The War Memorial has now been tidied up by Ron Cornell at a cost of £30.
- (380) Letter from Great Witchingham Playgroup requesting a donation to help running costs. The Council agreed to make a donation of £25 and instructed the Clerk to make payment.
Letter from NCC Planning & Transportation Dept advising that repairs and improvements are to be made to Marriott's Way from October and that from time to time closure of sections of the pathway may be necessary.
- (381) Planning Applications: No new applications were received but approval was granted for the temporary siting of the marquee at Lenwade House Hotel and alterations to Manor House Farm for Mr. & Mrs. Barratt.

The planning Enforcement matter relating to Rami Manor has been suspended since the council understands the sale of the property to be proceeding and the new owner does not intend to use it as anything other than a residence.

The footpath at the corner of Bridge Garage is to be improved and some of the road signs relocated to make it safer.

The Clerk was instructed to ascertain whether permission to display a sign on the Council verge outside Bridge Garage, had been obtained.
